

COMMUNITY SUPPORT BREAKS RECORDS

East Fort Bend Human Needs Ministry is pleased to report that this year's Feinstein Challenge brought in a *RECORD* number of donations to the Food Pantry! During March and April, the Food Pantry received over 40,000 food items donated from various food drives held throughout the community. (For this challenge, food items were given a value of \$1 each.) In addition, we received \$82,602 in monetary donations to the Ministry! The total value of these donations is a record-breaking \$122,367!

For the tenth straight year, philanthropist, Alan Feinstein is dividing \$1 million among the hunger fighting agencies that participated in this challenge nationwide. Founded in 1991 by Mr. Feinstein, the Feinstein Foundation is dedicated to philanthropic endeavors focusing on the alleviation of hunger and the importance of community service.

All donations to the Food Pantry received during March and April were counted as part of the Feinstein Challenge. This year's Challenge was such a HUGE success because of the generosity of many of our coalition churches, local schools, area businesses and civic organizations that came together to help end hunger in our community.
