

S.O.S. PROGRAM IN 6TH YEAR

Now that school is out for summer break it's time to get started on 'Supply Our Students' a/k/a the S.O.S. Ministry. In its sixth year, this program was developed to provide new school supplies to eligible Pre-K - 12th grade students within the Stafford Municipal and Fort Bend Independent School Districts.

The S.O.S. program began at Christ United Methodist Church as a way to give new school supplies to children who otherwise would not receive them. Additional support from other coalition churches and area civic organizations has allowed the S.O.S. program to expand the school supply packets to include new backpacks. "The happiness and joy shown on the faces of the children when they pick up their new school supplies along with a brand new backpack is priceless. All children deserve to have the proper supplies they need to start off the new school year," said Sandy Jordan, S.O.S. program coordinator. "Our goal this year is to provide 400 students with new school supply packets."

Eligible residents in Fort Bend County are asked to come to East Fort Bend Human Needs Ministry on Monday, July 9th between 10 a.m. — 1 p.m. to sign up for the school supplies. School supply packets will be distributed on Monday, August 13th between the hours of 10 a.m. — 2 p.m.
