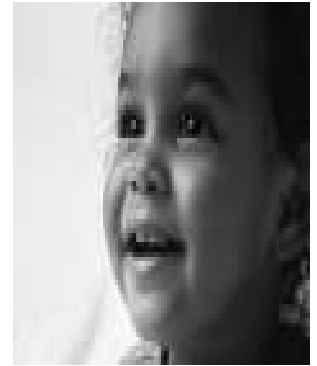


## Did you know?



- East Fort Bend Human Needs Ministry, Inc. served 15,970 families in 2006—  
26,431 adults & 17,322 children.
- 42,194 people were assisted through the Food Pantry.
- 1,559 residents were provided financial assistance for rent/mortgage and utilities.
- The value of food distributed in 2006 was \$570,681.
- The amount of financial assistance provided in 2006 was over \$124,271.
- Because of the food provided by the Food Pantry:
  - 16,419 children did not go hungry.
  - 7,240 homebound senior citizens received food.
  - 2,398 people were able to celebrate Thanksgiving and Christmas with traditional turkey dinners.
  - 9,723 people received fresh produce and food during Food Fairs sponsored by the Houston Food Bank.
- Through the Financial Assistance Program:
  - 789 people were allowed to remain in their homes.
  - 445 children avoided becoming homeless.
  - 208 families were able to keep their utilities connected.
- In 2006 volunteers contributed 16,185 hours to the Food Pantry, Financial Assistance Program, and Resale Shop valued at \$ 275,145!
